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Day by Day Itinerary

Day 1: Departure: Depart USA: Our spiritual pilgrimage begins as we board our transatlantic flight to Warsaw. Meals and refreshments will be served aloft.

Day 2: Arrive Krakow: Upon arrival in Krakow, one of Poland's most beautiful and historic cities, we are warmly welcomed by our local representative and transferred to our hotel. After time to settle in, we begin to experience the spiritual and cultural richness of this remarkable city, which served as the home of Pope John Paul II for many years. This evening, we gather for our welcome dinner, offering an opportunity to meet fellow pilgrims and prepare spiritually for the days ahead as we begin our journey in the footsteps of the saints of Poland.
Overnight: Krakow (Dinner*)

Day 3: Krakow: Czestochowa, Jasna Góra Monastery, Black Madonna: This morning we depart Krakow and travel to Czestochowa, a city that for more than 600 years has been the spiritual heart of Catholic Poland and one of the most important pilgrimage destinations in Europe. Upon arrival, we visit the renowned Jasna Góra Monastery, a sacred site of great religious, historical, and artistic significance. Here we will have the opportunity to participate in the moving unveiling of the miraculous icon of the Black Madonna of Czestochowa, one of the most beloved Marian images in the world. Our guide will lead us through the beautiful Chapel of Our Lady, where the famous icon hangs above a magnificent silver and ebony altar. We will also visit the monastery treasury and celebrate Holy Mass at this sacred shrine. After lunch, we continue to the Auschwitz-Birkenau Memorial and Museum for a guided visit of the former concentration camp. This solemn site stands as a powerful memorial to the millions who lost their lives during World War II and invites us to pause in prayer and reflection. Later in the afternoon we return to Krakow, where we enjoy dinner and overnight.
Overnight: Krakow (Breakfast, Dinner)

Day 4: Krakow: Wawel Hill, Church of St. Stanislaw, Kanonicza Street, St. Faustina Shrine: Following breakfast, proceed to Wawel Hill and celebrate mass at the Church of St. Stanislaw, Poland's second most important pilgrimage shrine. Visit Krakow's cathedral which serves as the nation's spiritual capital and has witnessed most of the royal coronations and funerals of the last millennium. See the Cathedral's Treasury and continue to Krakow's Old Town to see Kanonicza Street where Pope John Paul II resided while living in Krakow. Visit the courtyard of the Collegium Maius; see the ancient Market Square and Cloth Hall. This afternoon stops at Lagwieniki to visit St. Faustina Shrine before returning to Krakow.
Overnight: Krakow (Breakfast, Dinner)

Day 5: Krakow: Wieliczka Salt Mines, Wadowice, Kalwaria Zebrzydowska: This morning we drive to Wieliczka to see the oldest salt mine in Europe, a world-class tourist attraction. It is a unique place where many generations of Polish miners have created a world of underground salt lakes with a rich interior of decorated chapels including the famous Blessed Kings Chapel, plus other galleries and workings made of salt. Wieliczka salt mine is listed by UNESCO as a World Cultural Heritage Site. Then proceed to Wadowice, birthplace of Karol Wojtyla, the late Pope John Paul II. His museum is in his family house. Continue to a place that was a popular pilgrimage place for the Pope when he was a young man: Kalwaria Zebrzydowska, where in the 17th century the Palatine of Krakow founded a Franciscan Monastery. The church has very rich Baroque decorations. On the slope of the hill and in the valley is an architectural 'Way of the Cross' comprising 42 Mannerist and Baroque chapels and some small Calvary churches.
Overnight: Krakow (Breakfast, Dinner)

Day 6: Krakow / Prague: Velehrad, Prague: Depart this morning for the Czech capital of Prague. En route stop at Velehrad to visit the Shrine in memory of the two missionaries from Byzantium, 'Cyril and Methodius', who brought Christianity to the Czech lands. In 1985 His Holiness Pope John Paul II conferred the 'Golden Rose' on Velehrad, a

Papal distinction conveyed to only three other venerable places of pilgrimage, Lourdes, Guadalupe and Czestochowa. Continue to the 'Golden City' of Prague, one of Europe's most attractive capitals.
Overnight: Prague (Breakfast, Dinner)

Day 7: Prague: Prague Castle, St. Vitus Cathedral, the Church of Our Lady of Victory: Spanning the River Vltava, Prague ranks as one of the most beautifully preserved cities in Europe. The town is famous for its Gothic and Baroque architecture. Wonder at the graceful enormity of Prague Castle and St. Vitus Cathedral, the Church of Our Lady of Victory and the statue of the Infant Jesus of Prague. After mass, cross the historic Charles Bridge, built in 1400, and admire its Baroque statuary. Continue to the Loreto Shrine, one of the most important places of pilgrimage in Eastern Europe. Recall the timeless masterpieces of Mozart, Wagner and Berlioz while viewing the city's many theaters and opera houses.
Overnight: Prague (Breakfast, Dinner)

Days 8: Depart Prague: Flights to Medjugorje: Today, you will depart early in the morning for your flights to Medjugorje. Upon arrival, you'll be greeted by our guide and/or driver who will then take you to a scenic transfer to the serene town of Medjugorje. Upon Arrival, check in to your hotel, where you can unwind and refresh. As evening falls, savor a delicious dinner featuring local cuisine, followed by a restful overnight stay in the peaceful ambiance of Medjugorje, setting the tone for your upcoming adventures.
Overnight: Medjugorje (Breakfast, Dinner)

Days 9: Medjugorje: St. James Church, Apparition Hill, Cross Mountain & Cenacolo: Welcome to Medjugorje, a place known throughout the world for its simplicity, peace, and powerful spiritual renewal. Upon arrival, our local guide will accompany us as we begin our pilgrimage in this blessed village where millions come seeking prayer, healing, and reconciliation. We begin our day at St. James Church Medjugorje, the spiritual heart of the parish. Pilgrims will participate in Holy Mass (English-speaking, depending on the parish schedule) and receive the special blessing of religious articles after Mass. Following Mass, we will visit the nearby Statue of the Risen Christ, a peaceful place of prayer and reflection where pilgrims often pause for quiet devotion. Afterward, we will climb Apparition Hill, the place where the Blessed Virgin Mary first appeared to the young visionaries in 1981. As we ascend the rocky path, we will pray together and spend time in personal reflection at the statue of Our Lady. In the afternoon, we will visit the inspiring Cenacolo Community, where members of this faith-based community share powerful testimonies of conversion and new life through prayer, work, and devotion. For those who are able, we will also have the opportunity to climb Mount Krizevac (Cross Mountain), praying the Stations of the Cross along the way and reflecting on the Passion of Christ beneath the large concrete cross erected in 1934. In the evening, we return to St. James Church to join pilgrims from around the world in the evening prayer program, including the Holy Rosary and Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament (depending on the parish schedule). This powerful communal prayer experience is one of the most moving moments of the Medjugorje pilgrimage.
Overnight: Medjugorje (Breakfast, Dinner)

Day 10: Return Flights Home: After an early breakfast, we bid farewell to the beautiful coastal city of Split and transfer to Split Airport for our return journey home. We return with hearts full of gratitude and a desire to live our faith more deeply each day.

Below are the general terms & conditions. Dates and fees may change from tour to tour. For tour-specific information please refer to the terms and conditions on the travel brochure specific to your tour.

By making any payments (cash, credit card or otherwise) towards any tour constitutes your unconditional acceptance of all the terms and conditions stated in this brochure. Pax Via Tours & Travel Inc. shall be referred to as PVTT within this document.

DOCUMENTS: US citizens require a valid passport. Other nationalities please inquire with the appropriate embassies.

REGISTRATION AND DEPOSIT: Deposit of \$500 per person is required upon registration along with a signed copy of the registration form. Registrations are processed in the order received by PVTT. Final payment is due 45 days prior to departure. Late payments are subject to a \$50 late fee per week past the due date. PVTT reserves the right to cancel reservations whose payments are 30 days late and to apply applicable cancellation/penalties indicated below. No registrations can be made over the telephone.

INDIVIDUAL CANCELLATION FEES & REFUNDS: Upon cancellation of participation of tour by you, the registrant, for any reason, and only after PVTT receives your written cancellation via email used to register or by US mail, PVTT will then refund your payment for services not received by you, minus applicable cancellation fees per person, according to the following schedule: All refunds will be processed via check. Credit card fees are collected by the payment processor and will not be refunded.

Minimum cancellation fee is \$500 from time of registration up to 120 days prior to the tour's departure date.

From 119 to 60 days prior to departure day, the cancellation fee is \$500 + 20% of total price.

From 59 days to 31 days prior to departure day, cancellation fee is \$500 + 50% of total price.

From 30 days prior to departure day onward, no refund is possible.

PAYMENT: Advertised price is the cash/check discounted price. If paying with a card, a processing fee will apply. Card processing fee is nonrefundable.

BOUNCED CHECKS: Bounced checks will incur a \$25 administrative fee.

DISPUTED PAYMENTS: In the event of a disputed payment for reasons other than a fraudulent charge, the administrative fees associated with a dispute will be invoiced to your account and either deducted from your refund or invoiced to you. These fees are subject to change due to payment processors' rules and regulations.

TRAVEL PROTECTION: Travel insurance is recommended to help protect you and your trip investment against the unexpected. For your convenience, we offer travel protection. If you do not wish to purchase now, the plan can be purchased any time before submitting your final payment. Coverage takes effect once payment is received. If you choose to purchase outside of the time-sensitive period outlined in the plan, you will not be eligible for time-sensitive benefits. All plan premiums are non-refundable. MEDICAL CONDITION: We endeavor to provide the highest level of service to all our passengers. Participants who require special assistance must be accompanied by a qualified helper who assumes total responsibility for the participants' well-being. This pilgrimage demands a lot of walking and can be strenuous. PVTT is not responsible for any medical conditions that occur prior to, during, or after the tour.

LAND TRANSPORTATION AND TRANSFERS: By private deluxe motor coach.

ACCOMMODATIONS: Tour prices are per person, based on two persons sharing double or twin-bedded rooms with a private bathroom with tub or shower. In the event that one does not sign up with a roommate and is not able to be paired with another traveler, there will be a single supplement charge to the account. Single rooms subject to availability and an additional cost indicated on the brochure. Accommodations are subject to change due to upgrade, size of group, etc.

MOBILE APP: Final pilgrimage details will be available through an app before departure. Please be aware that the information on the app is regularly updated and subject to change. PVTT holds no liability for errors or discrepancies in the app's content.

MEALS: Meals in accordance with the itinerary. All beverages are extra.

TIPPING: Unless it is specified in the tour brochure, the price of the tour does not include tips and gratuities. Tipping is recommended to the tour guide and motor coach driver approximately \$6 and \$4 per person, respectively, per day to each. Hotel tips are approximately \$2 per day per person. Tips may be pre-collected before the pilgrimage for your convenience.

AIRLINE TICKETS AND ITINERARY LENGTH: Air transportation to/from your destination will be economy class aboard carriers utilizing non-refundable, non-amenable tickets. Preliminary international flight schedules are available 60 days prior to departure and may change before they are finalized. Therefore, if you book the domestic flight on your own, you will be responsible for changing your domestic flights and incurring any change fees that would be generated by this adjustment. We are not responsible for changes and delays in airline schedules and do not reimburse passengers for expenses resulting from such occurrences. Travelers making their own flight arrangements should not purchase non-refundable, non-changeable tickets. We cannot

guarantee the most direct routing to your final destination. If flight schedules change, we reserve the right to lengthen or shorten the itinerary accordingly, and if changes or flight schedules necessitate extra overnights, you will be charged at normal hotel rates. Land Only packages do not include airport-hotel transfers.

SEAT ASSIGNMENT: THERE IS NO ADVANCE SEAT SELECTION FOR TOUR DEPARTURES. PVTT cannot guarantee specific seats, which are at the discretion of the airline and are pending availability. When PVTT disperses travel packages, you will receive your record locator. You can use this locator to do online seating arrangements, if permitted by the airline. Any additional costs for seat selection are your responsibility. If your airline ticket is canceled for any reason, you must directly contact the airline to request a refund for your seat selection. The refund will be processed to your original form of payment, subject to the airline's terms and conditions.

BAGGAGE: Transatlantic and transpacific flights to and from the USA allow the passenger to bring one (1) checked bag, which may have a maximum weight of 50 lbs., and maximum combined dimensions of 62 inches. Also, one (1) "carry-on" with maximum dimensions of 8"x12"x20" is permitted. Luggage on domestic flights including Mexico & Canada will cost extra. Luggage is the passenger's responsibility and that of the airlines. For lost luggage, the passenger is responsible for notifying the airline directly. Check with your carrier regarding carry-on luggage rules and regulations. **PRICES:** All prices are based on exchange rates and fares applicable at the time of quotation and based on the minimum number of paying passengers stated in the brochure and are therefore subject to change if fares change (including fuel surcharges increase), if the group does not reach the minimum or if exchange rates fluctuate. Minimum number of paying passengers is 30.

NOT INCLUDED: Passport and Visas, exit taxes, meals not mentioned, beverages with meals, extras beyond the standard menu, excess baggage, luggage on domestic flights, telephone calls, fuel surcharges increase.

VISA FOR EUROPE – ETIAS -Starting in 2025, Americans, Canadians, Australians will need to apply online for travel authorization for Europe. – This applies to all travelers, and all ages. – Fee approx. \$9 per person – The program is called ETIAS. Some refer to it as a "visa for Europe". It is not a traditional visa but needs basic details about the traveler and their trip.
